

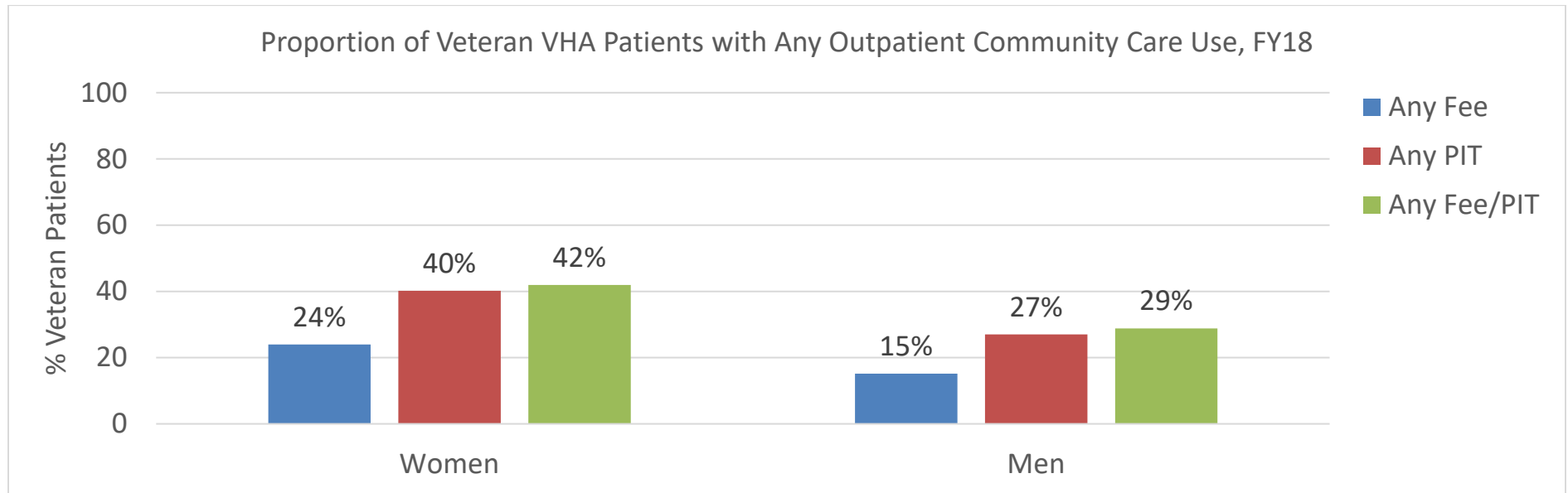

### Summary (Preliminary):

- Among women Veteran VHA patients in the FY18 WHEI cohort, 24% had an outpatient encounter in Fee, 40% had a PIT outpatient encounter, and 42% had both a Fee and PIT outpatient encounter in FY18.
- A higher proportion of women than men had any outpatient CC use in FY18 (42% vs. 29%).
